

I Saw a Little Bunny

Singing and reciting nursery rhymes boosts children's language and literacy skills.

- Practise the actions first before you try to combine them with the words.
- Younger children will find it difficult to co-ordinate the words with the actions.

I saw a little bunny go hop, hop, hop.
(Hop 3 times)

I saw his ears go flop, flop, flop.
(Put hands to ears and flop them 3 times)

I saw his nose go wink, wink, wink.
(Twitch your nose up and down)

I saw his eyes go blink, blink, blink.
(Blink 3 times)

I said, "Little bunny, won't you stay?"
(Beckon with index finger)

He looked at me and he hopped away.
(Hop)
